We are very proud to announce that Roseberry has been awarded the **Bronze Kitemark** for our work in P.E. and sport.

Our joint work with Gonadeniya Maha Vidyalaya in Sri Lanka and a series of international themed projects throughout the year has resulted in Roseberry being awarded **the full International School Award.**



Roseberry is very proud to announce that we have been awarded **Artsmark Gold** status. Artsmark is Arts Council England's flagship programme to enable schools and other organisations to evaluate, strengthen and celebrate their arts and cultural provision. Artsmark is nationally recognised as demonstrating excellence in arts and cultural provision. Holding Artsmark status demonstrates that your school or setting values the arts and culture. Artsmark also contributes to the cultural aspect of Ofsted's requirement that a school promotes students' spiritual, moral, social and cultural development.

The summary of our arts provision stated that, "Roseberry Primary has large facilities for under 200 pupils which enables them to enjoy (for example) a large and airy, well-lit art room. There is a lot of space to display work and this is done to great effect. Percentage curriculum hours are good and extra-curricular take up high. All art forms are including in a varied and creative curriculum. Governors are closely involved, from attending planning meetings to acting as a judge for arts competitions. They are proud of the teachers' creativity. Children have access to quality and stimulating arts practitioners and the school has a close relationship with The Forge, who fully supported the Gold application. Roseberry has a strong profile for the arts, is often featured in press and media and displays work, such as their miners' banner in other settings e.g. the local community centre and Beamish museum."
