



What will we be learning? Year 1 Hazel Autumn 1

In English we will learn to:

- create ideas from a picture storybook
- form lower case letters correctly
- write simple captions
- generate adjectives verbally
- begin to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops
- begin to write simple sentences

In PSHE we will learn to:

- how to recognise who to trust and who not to trust
- how to judge when a friendship is making them feel unhappy or uncomfortable
- managing conflict
- how to manage these situations
- how to seek help or advice from others, if needed
- use manners
- respecting one another

In Art we will learn to:

- use a variety of different tools including pencils, rubbers, crayons, pastels, felt tips, charcoal, ball points, chalk and other dry media.
- use a sketchbook to gather and collect artwork.
- begin to explore the use of line, shape and colour.

In Science we will learn to:

- distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made
- identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water and rock
- describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials
- compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of the simple physical properties

In Music we will learn to:

- find and keep a steady pulse
- play or clap simple rhythmic patterns using long and short sounds
- respond to different high and low pitches
- keep a steady beat when improvising
- improvising using one, two or three notes
- listen to music carefully, move to the music
- respond to questions and use any musical words you know

In PE we will learn to:

- moving into different positions before throwing
- throwing with a suitable underarm technique
- moving to try to intercept the beanbags
- changing speed and direction easily
- changing their approach in response to their opponents actions
- scoring accurately in the game

In RE we will learn to:

- Why is the Bible special to Christians?
- What does it mean to belong to Christianity?

In Maths we will learn to:

- sort and count objects
- represent objects
- recognise numbers as words
- count on from any number
- 1 more
- count backwards within 10
- 1 less
- compare groups by matching
- fewer, more, same
- less than, greater than, equal to
- compare numbers
- order objects and numbers
- the number line

In Geography we will learn to:

- draw and label pictures to show location
- use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to physical and human features such as: city, town, village, river, forest, sea
- use directional language to describe a route or give directions (e.g. next to, behind, near, far, left, right)
- make a simple map.
- use photos to locate a familiar place.
- draw simple sketches.
- observe and record information about the local area
- look at a simple map of the local area and identify the things they know and have seen.

In Computing we will learn to:

- log in
- find saved work
- become familiar with icons on the desktop
- learn how to open, save and print
- understand the importance of logging out
