As explorers and investigators we will: Explore signs of winter and learn about changes in our weather.



We will learn about



nocturnal/hibernating animals and the differences between day and night. We will also use magnets to begin to investigate forces.

As mathematicians we will:

We will continue to develop our counting and cardinality skills, learning how to rote count, touch and count and subitise. We will learn about the concept of time, from day to night, and we will sort related items.

We will develop spatial vocabulary, and construct with 2D and 3D shape, using positional language to talk about our creations. We will talk about the names of shapes and we will learn about the properties of these shapes.

As artists, actors and musicians:

Make nests for hibernating animals.

Make day/ night sounds using instruments.

We will prepare for our Christmas play, learning new songs and how to be confident performers.

We would love to practise our Christmas play songs at home so that we can be especially confident when we perform.

As communicators we will:

Play listening games and building a bank of exciting words to describe day and night.

We will discuss our dreams and fears of the dark.
