In PSHE we will learn about:

Physical health and Mental wellbeing: What affects mental health and ways To take care of it; managing change, loss and bereavement; managing time online If you have any questions regarding these topics, please get in contact.

In Geography we will learn about:

Global trade. We will be looking at where the products and services we use come from and how trade has developed over time.

We will look at what we produce as a country and why, including highest value exports of different countries.

In PE we will learn:

the children create and perform a group dance that portrays the routines and emotions involved in taking tests or exams. The final performance is made up of five sections: entering the exam room; getting to a chair; sitting down to the exam paper; getting off the chair; leaving the exam room.

In Drama we will:


Be rehearsing for our Christmas production of "Christmas with the Krackers", which we will be performing on the run up to Christmas.

Our class novel this half term is: Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone



In English we will learn:

When to start a new paragraph.

How to create character using show not tell and write a new Potions lesson.

Write description, action, dialogue and whereabouts sentences.

Use speech punctuation accurately.

We will also continue to develop knowledge around our reading domains, particularly inference and vocabulary.

In Music we will learn:

The songs for our Christmas production as well as continuing our focus musician studies.

Our focus musician for this half term is Stevie Wonder

In Maths we will learn about:

Multiplication and division.

We will learn about multiples and factors of numbers including common factors and common multiples. We will also learn how to multiply and divide two and three-digit numbers.

We will learn formal methods of long multiplication and long division up to 4 digits by 2 digits.

In RE we will learn about:

Why Jewish people visit the Synagogue. This continues our study of Judaism from last half term, where we will learn about the practices and traditions that happen in Jewish communities and their religious buildings.

We will also look at the Themes of Christmas linked to Christianity

In Science we will learn about:

Forces, which will include:

- explaining that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object
- identifying the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction, that act between moving surfaces
- recognising that some mechanisms including levers, pulleys and gears allow a smaller force to have a greater effect.
