

In Science we will learn to:

- Plan and investigate how different materials will affect how something travels.
- We will also look in detail how to undertake a fair test, using vocabulary such as 'variable'.
- Explore magnets and understand when magnets attract/repel.

In maths we will learn to:

- Add and subtract using formal written methods.
- We will look at area exploring what 'area' means and how to compare different areas of shapes.
- We will focus further this term on our multiplication and division facts, including how to multiply a number by 1 and itself.

In music we will:

- Celebrate a wide range of music styles linked to the theme 'How does music connect us with our past' including by listening, singing, playing, composing and performing.

In computing we will learn to:

- use a range of techniques to create a stop-frame animation using tablets.

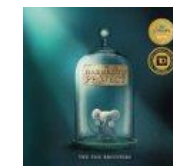
In PE we will learn to:
