In English we will learn to:

- form lower case letters correctly
- say aloud what they want to write about
- begin to write simple sentences
- generate adjectives and use them within sentences
- extend their sentences by using the conjunction 'and'
- begin to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops
- spell words containing each of the phonemes already taught
- spell some Year 1 common exception words correctly

In RE we will learn:

- What does it mean to belong to Christianity?
- Why is light important at Christmas?

In PSHE we will learn:

- what it means to healthy and why it is important
- ways to take care of ourselves on a daily basis
- about basic hygiene routines, e.g. hand washing
- about healthy and unhealthy foods, including sugar intake
- about physical activity and how it keeps people healthy
- about different types of play, including balancing indoor, outdoor and screen-based play
- about people who can help them stay healthy, such as parents, doctors, nurses, dentists, lunch supervisors
- how to keep safe in the sun



What will we be learning? Year 1 Hazel Autumn 2

In Computing we will learn to:

- understand that an algorithm is a set of instructions used to solve a problem or achieve an objective.
- work out what is wrong with a simple algorithm when the steps are out of order and can write their own simple algorithm
- read code one line at a time

In Science we will learn to:

- identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals
- identify and name a variety of animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores
- describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals (fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds, mammals, including pets)
- identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense

In Maths we will learn to:

- use a part-whole model
- write number sentences
- write addition facts related to a fact family
- identify number bonds within 10
- recite and apply number bonds to 10

- add numbers together
- add more
- answer addition problems

In History we will learn to:

- share what they know about modern housing today by discussing the house they live in, what it looks like on the inside/outside
- identify and name the types of houses in our own locality (e.g. detached, semi-detached, terraced, bungalow, flat)
- identify changes to the inside/outside of houses as we go back through time, a decade at a time
- discuss the impact of these changes on life today
- use sources of evidence (e.g artefacts, photographs, maps, aerial photos, floorplans, artefacts) to gain an insight into what life was life at that time in history.

In PE we will learn to:

- be creative
- understand level, speed and direction
- move expressively and confidently
- show good body control
- use space well
- create sequences with a clear start, middle and end
- remember, repeat and link movement phrases
- talk about the effect of movements on their heartbeat
