In Science we will learn to:

- Identify the names of some of the bones in the human body and understand that we need bones for support, protection and movement.
- Identify how humans use muscles.
- Identify the five main food groups that humans need in order to have a healthy balanced diet.

In maths we will learn to:

- •-Recall multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12 x 12.
- •-Recognise and use factor pairs when calculating mentally.
- •-Multiply by 1 and 0
- •-Divide a number by 1 and itself.
- •-Multiply and divide numbers by 10 and 100.
