In Science we will learn to:

- Identify the names of some of the bones in the human body and understand that we need bones for support, protection and movement.
- Identify how humans use muscles.
- Identify the five main food groups that humans need in order to have a healthy balanced diet.

In maths we will learn to:

- Recall multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12 x 12.
- Recognise and use factor pairs when calculating mentally.
- Multiply by 1 and 0
- Divide a number by 1 and itself.
- Multiply and divide numbers by 10 and 100.

In RE we will learn:

- About different Christian symbols and their different beliefs.
- We will explore what they mean to Christians and how they are used in church.

In computing we will learn to:

- Explain how algorithms work
- Detect and correct errors in algorithms and programs





In Art we will learn to:

- Research, create and refine a print using a variety of materials, objects and techniques including layering.
- Talk about the processes used to produce a simple print and select broadly the materials to print in order to get the effect they want.

In PE we will learn:

- How to create a gymnastics sequence with six actions on floor, mats and apparatus.
- Develop body part balances linked through travelling, rolling and jumping.
